Group Chief Economist, The Royal Bank of Scotland

Jeremy Peat undertook his economics training at Bristol University and University College London and has been Group Chief Economist at The Royal Bank of Scotland for over a decade. Previously, he was an economic adviser to UK and overseas Governments, acting as Senior Economic Adviser at the Scottish Office from 1985 to 1993.

At the Royal Bank, Jeremy is responsible for economic advice across the Royal Bank Group. His team of economists provides advice on international, UK macro and sectoral issues. Jeremy is also responsible for the Royal Bank's Group EMU Office, keeping a close watch on developments regarding the single European currency and potential implications for the bank and its customers. He is the UK representative on the Economic and Monetary Affairs Committee of the European Banking Federation. He is a member of the Confederation of British Industry's Economic Affairs Committee as well as the UK Secretary of State for Trade and Industry's Panel for Monitoring the Economy. He is also a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Bankers in Scotland.
