The **21st Annual Eurasian/Russian - American Innovation Technology Week (RANIT)** will take place from November 29th to December 6th, 2016 in Philadelphia, PA and the Mid-Atlantic Region. It will focus on biotechnology, the pharmaceutical industry, medical equipment, life sciences, alternative energy, nanotechnology, the chemical industry, information technology, technology in education, and entrepreneurship. The RANIT is a multi-industry event, highlighting increased involvement by key Eurasian and American policy-makers. Annual RANIT events include a Welcoming Ceremony and Opening Sessions at Philadelphia City Hall, a Welcoming Reception at the top of the Comcast Center, Annual Eurasian/Russian – American Life Sciences Innovation Conference at the Wistar Institute, and the Eurasian/Russian-American Innovation Technology Commercialization Roundtable at the University City Science Center.



This year's **21st Annual Eurasian-American Innovation Technology Week** will include the **Days of Eurasian-American Innovation Entrepreneurship Cooperation (RAVC 2016)**, which will be held in Philadelphia, PA November 29 to December 2, 2016. Under the framework of RAVC 2016, MAEBC/MARBC is organizing the **Annual Eurasian/Russian – American Technology Entrepreneurship Conference** on December 1, 2016, and is facilitating Russian participation in the **Mid-Atlantic Venture Conference (IMPACT 2016)**. IMPACT is one of the oldest venture capital events in the United States that gives the participants a unique opportunity to access private investors and the largest regional venture funds.
