# 20<sup>th</sup> Annual Eurasian/Russian - American Innovation Technology Week & Days of Eurasian-American Innovation Entrepreneurship Cooperation

2015 will mark the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Mid-Atlantic – Eurasia Business Council (MAEBC/MARBC). The most significant MAEBC/MARBC-organized events in 2015 will include the 20<sup>th</sup> Annual Eurasian/Russian - American Innovation Technology Week (RANIT) on June 11-25, 2015 and the Days of Eurasian/Russian - American Innovation Entrepreneurship Cooperation (RAVC 2015) on October 28 – November 4, 2015. The 20<sup>th</sup> RANIT will include discussions with business leaders, policymakers, financiers, and technology corporations to promote technological cooperation between Eurasian, Russian, and American businesses. RAVC 2015 will bring together entrepreneurs, scientists, venture capitalists, and established Eurasian and American corporations to explore and shape the field of innovation technology. RANIT and RAVC programs and activities are designed to help foster dialogue and cooperation. They are supported by nearly 30 leading American, Eurasian, and Russian business and governmental organizations, including the administrations of the City of Philadelphia and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and Mid-Atlantic regional organizations focusing on international business, technology, innovations, and entrepreneurship. Eurasian and Russian delegations that will take part in these events will consist of representatives from the foremost Eurasian and Russian companies and educational institutions in innovation technology and related industries.

The 20<sup>th</sup> Annual Eurasian/Russian - American Innovation Technology Week (RANIT) will take place in Philadelphia, Washington, D.C., New York and the Mid-Atlantic Region from June 11-25, 2015. It will focus on biotechnology, the pharmaceutical industry, medical equipment, life sciences, alternative energy, nanotechnology, the chemical industry, information technology, technology in education, and entrepreneurship.

Key RANIT events will include a **Welcoming Ceremony and Opening Sessions** in the Mayor's Reception Room at Philadelphia City Hall on June 11, the **Eurasian/Russian - American Life Sciences Innovation Conference** in Philadelphia on June 11-12, the **Eurasian/Russian - American Innovation Technology, University Research & Commercialization Roundtable** at the University City Science Center in Philadelphia, as well as Eurasian and Russian participation in the **2015 BIO International Convention** in Philadelphia, and **REFF Wall Street** in New York.

The **Eurasian/Russian - American Life Sciences Innovation Conference** is a multi-industry event, highlighting increased involvement by key Eurasian, Russian and American policy-makers. The discussion will include policy changes that have come as a result of the "Comprehensive Program of Biotechnology Development in Russia to 2020" and its effect on the Eurasian/Russian - American partnership in the life sciences industry.

As part of RAVC 2015, MAEBC/MARBC is organizing the Eurasian – American Technology Entrepreneurship Conference. MAEBC/MARBC is also facilitating Eurasian participation in the Mid-Atlantic Venture Conference (IMPACT 2015). IMPACT is one of the oldest venture capital events in the United States that gives the participants a unique opportunity to access private investors and the largest regional venture funds. Additional RAVC events will include a roundtable at the International Incubator at the Science Center, featuring presentations by company residents, including the first Russian company with an office at the University City Science Center in Philadelphia. For over 50 years, the Science Center has served as the biggest and oldest urban technology park in the United States.


