The Conference will take place in Quorum at the University City Science Center (3711 Market St., Philadelphia, PA), the biggest and oldest urban technology

As in previous years, the MAEBC/MARBC is continuing its commitment to being a supporting organization of IMPACT, bringing a delegation from the Eurasian venture industry and emerging Eurasian companies to participate at the conference. These events are a major part of the MAEBC/MARBC's 20th anniversary year celebration, and represent a continuation of the MAEBC/MARBC's twenty-year-long effort to develop Eurasian-American innovation entrepreneurship cooperation.
