The Conference will take place from 10:00 to 12:30 in Quorum at the University City Science Center (3711 Market St., Philadelphia, PA), the biggest and oldest urban technology park in the United States. is a key RAVC event, and will include a roundtable featuring presentations from the company-residents of the International Incubator, including the Science Center's first Russian company-resident, Optiflame, as well as presentations about entrepreneurial innovation systems in Russia, Israel and Bulgaria. The MAEBC will also be facilitating Eurasian participation in the Mid-Atlantic Venture Conference (IMPACT 2014) on October 28-29, one of the oldest venture capital events in the United States, which showcases young and developing companies and provides participants with a unique opportunity to access private investors and the largest regional venture funds. As in previous years, the MAEBC is continuing its commitment to being a supporting organization of IMPACT, bringing a delegation from the Eurasian venture industry and emerging Eurasian companies to participate at the conference. These events are a major part of the MAEBC's 20th anniversary year celebration, and represent a continuation of the MAEBC's twenty-year-long effort to develop Eurasian-American innovation entrepreneurship cooperation.
